

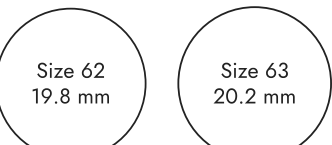
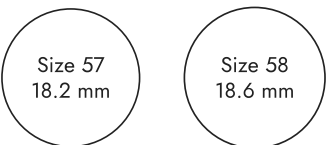
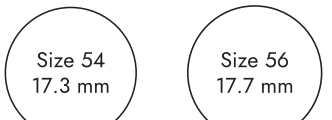
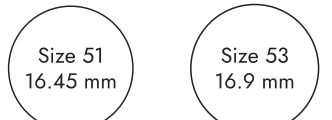
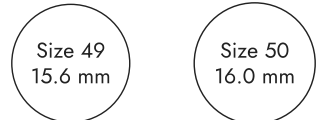
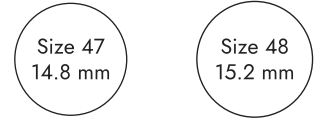
# Ring Size Guide

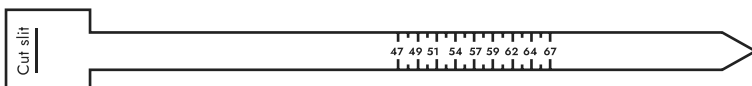
## Use a String

- Take a sufficiently large piece of string that you can handle easily, such as ribbons, yarn, or thread from a spool.
- MEASUREMENT: For accurate measurement, pass it under the finger to be measured. In the middle of the finger, mark a point on the string with a pen to indicate both parts of it.
- DETERMINATION: Finally, stretch the string out and evenly place it against the ruler in our size chart.
- Tip: Wrap the string around the finger and lightly tighten it! Try to achieve a comfortable and snug fit.
- Tip: Get assistance with the measurement for the best accuracy.
- CHECK: Double-check the accuracy once more.



## Using a Paper Strip

- Our ring size chart is provided on the right; print and carefully cut it out.
- Cut along the dotted end and then wrap it around your finger.
- Cut along the dotted line marked "Find your size" to create a slit.
- MEASUREMENT: Pull the pointed end until it fits snugly.
- DETERMINATION: The ring size will be indicated by the arrow.
- Tip: Make sure the paper is not wrapped too tightly. Try to achieve a comfortable and snug fit.
- Tip: Get assistance with the measurement for the best accuracy.
- CHECK: Double-check the accuracy once more.



## Secret Measurement

- Print out the ring size chart with circles, which is on the right.
- Try to find a ring that your loved one often wears.
- Make sure the person wears the ring on the finger for which you are buying it.
- MEASUREMENT: The ring should be placed on top of each circle until it fits perfectly.
- DETERMINATION: The match should fit perfectly inside the ring.
- CHECK: Double-check the accuracy once more.
